## Phase Four Plan

Phase Four, all instruction face to face 5 days a week.

Mandatory Parent Meeting, August 18, 2020 at 7 PM in the church. Face coverings and social distancing protocols will be followed.

- Prior to the first day of school, parents may drop off supplies in the front entry on Thursday, August 20 and Monday August 24 from 1 – 6 PM. Please bag supplies and label with name and grade. Supplies will be taken to the correct classrooms by staff.



### Safety Protocols:

### Illness Policy

- **By sending your child to school, you are indicating the following:**
  - ✓ That your child has not had a temperature above 100.4 degrees in the past 24 hours without medication.
  - ✓ That your child is not suffering from fever, cough, runny nose and /or congestion, tired and/or achy shortness of breath, sore throat or diarrhea, new loss of taste or smell.
  - ✓ That they have not had close contact with some who has been diagnosed with COVID-19 in the last 14 days.

**Having any of the above symptoms or conditions is reason for your child and for staff to stay home.**

- Staff will be screened daily and temperatures taken. Parents and students will need to follow the illness policy as stated above.



### Masks

- Masks will be worn by staff at all times except for meals.
- Masks will be worn by all students on the bus, hallway, and common areas.
- Students in K – 5 will not be required to but may wear masks in the classroom. Students in Grade 6 will wear masks in classroom.
- Homemade cloth masks **must be washed daily** and disposable ones replaced daily. Please mark your child's masks with their names. All unmarked masks will be thrown away if found on the floor. Clearly mark all items of clothing and water bottles with your child's name.



## Busing

- Masks must be worn at all times.
- Students will sanitize hands before entering the bus.
- Siblings will sit together.
- Buses will be sanitized before and after every route.

## School Day

- Specials teachers will move to the classrooms with the exception of Music, PE and art.
- Students will wash/sanitize hands between center activities, games, recess, lunch or movement from one room to another.
- Students will be staggered entering and exiting the building. They will go to recess, lunch and Mass in cohorts.
- Lunch will be served in the cafeteria in cohort groups.
- Students and staff must wash hands before and after meals. Teachers will instruct students on proper handwashing techniques and how to cough and sneeze in to their elbows.
- Students will go to recess in cohorts. Equipment will be sanitized after each use.
- Field trips and large assemblies are suspended.

## Visitors

- Adults visiting the school will be very limited. Parents will not be allowed entry in to the classrooms and cafeteria. There is a drop off space in the front entrance if you need to bring an item to school. All guests entering the building will be screened for symptoms, wear a facial covering, and sanitize hands prior to entering.
